OC1. <u>CONDUCT OFFICIAL CANVASS BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE</u> <u>ELECTION RETURNS FOR THE CITY OF CLEBURNE AND CLEBURNE</u> <u>INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON MAY 5, 2018.</u>

<u>BRIEF</u>: This meeting of the governing body shall serve as the official canvass of votes for the City of Cleburne and Cleburne Independent School District's General Election held May 5, 2018. Mayor Cain shall appoint two (2) Councilmembers and the City Secretary to review election returns submitted by the Precinct Judges for discrepancies. The Canvass Authority will then

adjourn to the Conference Room for their review and report back to the Council with their determination. According to Section 3-I of the Joint Election Agreement with the CISD, the City shall serve as the authority responsible for tabulating and canvassing the election returns for both political subdivisions and the City Secretary shall deliver the appropriate part of the tabulation to the CISD Presiding Officer so that the Board of Trustees may declare the results for their portion of the election.
