Summary: According to Article III, Section 1 of the corporation bylaws, the officers of President and Vice President serve a term of one year and are to be elected by the Board. At the August 9, 2022, meeting, the Board appointed Scott Cain as President and Derek Weathers as Vice-President, and both have served the full term.

6. Resolution 4A-08-2023-18

Consider a resolution approving the Type A Economic Development Corporation Sales Tax Fund Budget for Fiscal Year 2024.

Summary: Authorized for implementation by municipalities under the Texas Development Corporation Act of 1979 (Title 12 Subtitle C1, of the Texas Local Government Code), the ½ cent Cleburne Type A Corporation [aka 4A] sales tax was approved by Cleburne voters on November 3, 2015. This sales tax funds the payment of debt issued to finance construction of The Depot ballpark stadium at Cleburne Station Project and other associated expenses and the primary source of revenue is the ½-cent sales tax. The proposed fiscal year (FY) 2024 4A Sales Tax Corporation Fund budget includes projected total revenues of \$3,850,000.


The 4A Fund is anticipated to expend \$3,045,497 in FY 2024, an increase of \$322,582 from the prior fiscal year budget. The increase in expenditures is due primarily to the addition of infield turf replacement (\$250,000), carrying forward of funds from FY 2023 for Stadium

Enhancements (\$150,000), and an increase in property insurance (\$26,269). Proposed total expenditures include parkway/stadium related costs such as the annual stadium maintenance fund provision, enhancements, utilities, insurance, communications, fire alarm monitoring, annual inspections, general supplies, and debt service costs. The ending fund balance is expected to increase by \$804,503 for FY 2024 to \$12,006,959.
